Students may pre-register for the class at 269-445-1240. Students must be 12 years old by the date of the class. Please have the student's legal name, address, phone number, and date of birth at the time of registration. All classes will begin at 8:00 a.m. and should be done by 1:00 p.m. (EDT). Students are required to bring a #2 pencil, a sack lunch & something to drink. Upon successfully completing the course you will receive your boater safety certificate. Anyone born after July 1, 1996 is required to have a boater safety card to operate any vessel.
