This has really been a winter to remember, but summer is just around the corner. You can tell by the uptick in communications in anticipation of this DLYC season; our 80th. I want to take this opportunity to briefly update you on plans for this summer.

- **SPORTS COURT**--although the weather delayed any work this fall and is continuing to delay us this spring, Tommy Block and Bob Clark hope to have the court open by Memorial Day. The Youth Committee is making plans to use the court for tennis instruction this summer. And I am appointing a Players Committee to develop guidelines for court use, especially as it relates to Pickleball.
- **WATERFRONT ENHANCEMENT**-- Louie Csokasy has been working on a plan for improved use of our waterfront. While he has been "wading" through regulations and records, we may be able to install swimming lanes, improve usage of our two piers and upgrade our use of the shoreline. We are also exploring expanding our sailing fleet.
- **80TH ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATION**--Mike and Nancy Sharpe have developed preliminary plans for the celebration including layout, program, dinner, music, etc. Although we are not intending to replicate the incredible 75th Anniversary Celebration, this will be a very special, memorable event. Several subcommittees have been working on various aspects of the celebration. And Marilyn Quackenbush has spent hours designing and compiling a commemorative brochure for the event.
- **BERM BEAUTIFICATION**--last fall a committee led by Zane Lankford did some phase 1 planting. We are anxious to see how the plants do this spring and are intending a second phase of additional plantings. I was informed by the Cass County Conservation District that Midwest Energy will perform an extensive beautification project on both sides of the easement of M-60, which includes the backside of the berm facing the highway.
- **NEW MEMBERS**—A group is forming to organize a new member initiative through communications, realtor outreach and an Open House. Please be thinking about neighbors you may like to sponsor for membership.

A number of the standing committees have been working over the winter on their program plans for this season. The Social Committee has an especially exciting calendar that starts with the Derby Party in May.




